

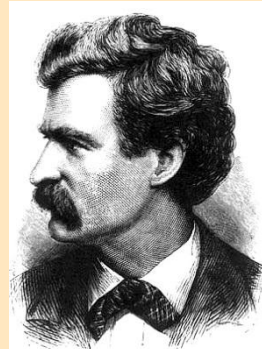
**The Man That Corrupted Hadleyburg, and Other Stories
